Federally Funded Research in Connecticut

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Connecticut from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Connecticut</u> received 1,179 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$510,609,681.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Connecticut</u> received 278 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$78,903,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in Connecticut received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$13,294,562.

Companies Created from Research in Connecticut

Kolltan Pharmaceuticals, founded in 2007 upon the research discoveries of Dr. Joseph Schlessinger of the Yale School of Medicine, develops next generation targeted medicines. The company's research focuses on creating more genetically precise cancer treatments based on an individual patient's molecular structure.
