Federally Funded Research in Delaware

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Delaware from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Delaware</u> received 75 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$45,371,848.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Delaware</u> received 126 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$45,446,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in Delaware received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$4,955,274.

Companies Created from Research in Delaware

ET International, Inc. (ETI) was founded in 2000 by Dr. Guang Gao, a Distinguished professor in computer and electrical engineering at the University of Delaware and a globally recognized expert in parallel computing. ETI provides software designed to increase performance, power, and efficiency in advanced many-core computing systems ranging from supercomputers to smart phones.
