Federally Funded Research in Idaho

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Idaho from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Idaho</u> received 19 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$14,139,675.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Idaho</u> received 78 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$22,984,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

During 2015, educational organizations in Idaho benefitted from DOE office of Science research awards worth \$915,000.

Companies Created from Research in Idaho

The Science Coalition's Sparking Economic Growth <u>reports</u> identify nearly 200 companies created as a result of federally funded university research across the country. These companies are bringing transformative innovations in energy, medicine, defense and technology to the market; creating new jobs and boosting local economies; and succeeding at rates far greater than most new businesses in the United States.
