Federally Funded Research in New Mexico

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in New Mexico from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>New Mexico</u> received 218 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$99,743,752.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>New Mexico</u> received 172 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$51,852,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in <u>New</u> <u>Mexico</u> benefitted research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$1,933,959.
