Federally Funded Research in Oklahoma

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Oklahoma from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Oklahoma</u> received 182 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$90,675,755.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Oklahoma</u> received 117 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$29,887,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in Oklahoma received research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$4,914,516.

Companies Created from Research in Oklahoma

Pure Protein L.L.C. focuses on the discovery of new targets to diagnose, prevent, and treat infectious disease and cancer. The company has created diagnostic kits for tissue typing and antibody screening and its technology is used to produce and validate vaccine targets. Pure Protein's core technology was developed by University of Oklahoma Professor William Hildebrand.
