University of Vermont

Federally Funded Research in Vermont

Federal funding for scientific research reaches every state in the nation. See the impact of funding to organizations in Vermont from three of the major government research agencies:

National Institutes of Health:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Vermont</u> received 115 awards from NIH, across all of its institutes, totaling \$48,758,135.

National Science Foundation:

In FY2016, organizations in <u>Vermont</u> received 34 awards from NSF, across all of its programs, totaling \$9,711,000.

Department of Energy Office of Science:

In 2015, educational organizations in <u>Vermont</u> benefitted from research awards from the DOE office of Science worth \$299,745.
